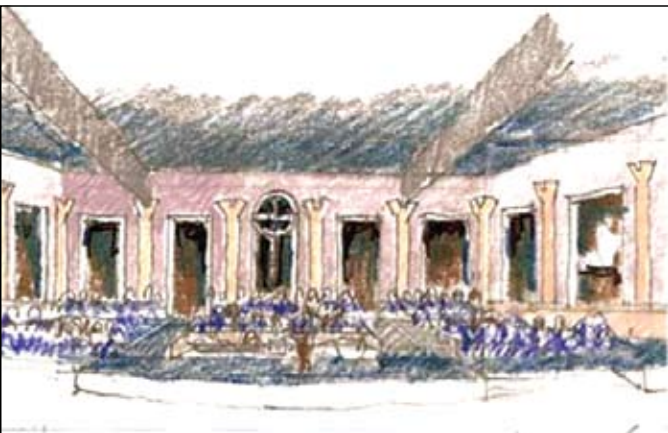
- *3,000 seat sanctuary*

FAQ Frequently Asked Questions

Q: 1. Why do we need to launch a 3-year capital campaign?

A: *There are monies that our bank loans do not cover and we want to pay off all loans as quickly as possible.*

Q: 2. How will this money be allocated?

A: *There are bills for items that must be paid and there is a list of priority construction elements to be completed.*

Q: 3. Why renovate the old Ellis Avenue Shopping Center when we could build a new church on McDowell Road?



A: *Bishop Ronnie C. Crudup, Sr. was told by God to be a "renovator"; God put the deteriorating shopping center on his heart and in his path. By renovating as instructed, an illustration of God's glory on earth will be manifested. God brought Isaiah 58:12 to the bishop's remembrance: "Your people*

will rebuild the ancient ruins and will raise up the age old foundations: you will be called Repairer of Broken Walls, Restorer of Streets with Dwellings."

Q: 4. What is planned for the McDowell Road property?



A: *The McDowell Road property will be developed into a valuable asset for the community by NHCI or we will decide who to sell the property to.*



Q: 5. What will happen to our Belvedere Drive church location?

A: *It will be sold or given away to another church.*

Q: 6. When will the first worship service be held at the Renaissance South location?

A: *November 15, 2009.*

Q: 7. How many seats are there in the sanctuary at Renaissance South?

A: *We have allocated 1,500 seats for this portion of the renovation project which is Phase I.*



Q: 8. Will the times of Sunday worship services (8 a.m. and 11 a.m.) remain the same?

A: *Yes.*

Q: 9. Will transportation continue to be provided to church members and visitors who desire to attend church?

A: *Yes.*



Q: 10. Where will children's church be held and how will it be staffed?

A: *The Children's Church area is being constructed along with a nursery area.*

Q: 11. Will there be a separate meeting area for Sunday School and education classes?

A: *There will be added education space.*

Q: 12. Will daily prayer at 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. continue to be held?
